We invite discussion regarding the creation of a fellowship and scholarship programme designed to support emerging leaders from Africa and Afro-descendant communities globally.

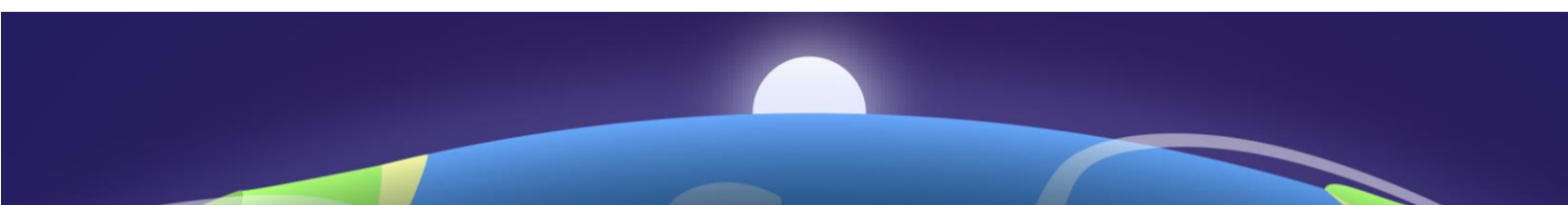
The programme would focus on leadership, sustainability, innovation, entrepreneurship, education, and community impact while building lasting connections across the Global African Family.
